Curriculum Structure for the Urban Renewal Credit Program of the University of Taipei

I. Purpose of Establishment

Taiwan is located in the Pacific Ring of Fire. In Taiwan, where over half of the buildings are over 30 years old, urban renewal is essential for improving disaster preparedness, enhancing quality of life, and facilitating urban transformation. Recognized as a key national policy, urban renewal requires a multidisciplinary approach. This credit program aims to cultivate professionals with theoretical knowledge and practical skills in urban renewal. The curriculum equips students with specialized knowledge, hands-on abilities, and interdisciplinary integration skills necessary for urban renewal projects, providing the professional manpower needed for urban renewal and enhancing students' future employment competitiveness.

II. Course Objectives and Features

- 1. Objectives of Curriculum
 - (1) To develop students' professional knowledge and skills in urban renewal, as well as interdisciplinary integration abilities. This program combines students' professional backgrounds and relevant knowledge through a comprehensive curriculum designed to cultivate talent in the field of urban renewal and to enhance the competencies required by the urban renewal industry.
 - (2) To align with industry, societal, and net-zero sustainability development trends, as well as the needs for talent in urban renewal policies and industry development, the program aims to establish correct concepts of urban renewal among students, enhance their professional ethics in urban renewal, and strengthen practical skills. The curriculum content is systematic and coherent, implemented through interdisciplinary integration, practical application, and other methods.
- 2. Features of Curriculum
 - (1) Emphasis on Interdisciplinary and Diverse Integration: This program integrates outstanding faculty from various fields, including urban planning, urban industry management, urban renewal, urban design, and urban disaster prevention, offering students diverse interdisciplinary learning opportunities and cultivating talent needed for

urban renewal development.

- (2) Emphasis on Practice and Innovation: The program focuses on the latest trends and policies in urban renewal. Students will gain a deep understanding of major current issues in urban renewal and have opportunities to participate in project-based practical operations, fostering innovative thinking and problem-solving skills.
- (3) Practical Orientation and Urban Renewal Planning Internship: The program emphasizes "learning by doing" through practical education. It includes an urban renewal planning internship course, featuring collaboration with industry professionals and central or local government agencies to enhance students' practical operational skills.

III. Core Competencies

- 1. Possess interdisciplinary integration knowledge and practical professional skills in urban renewal.
- 2. Demonstrate civic literacy with a focus on social concern.
- 3. Exhibit professional competitiveness in the fields of urban planning and urban renewal.
